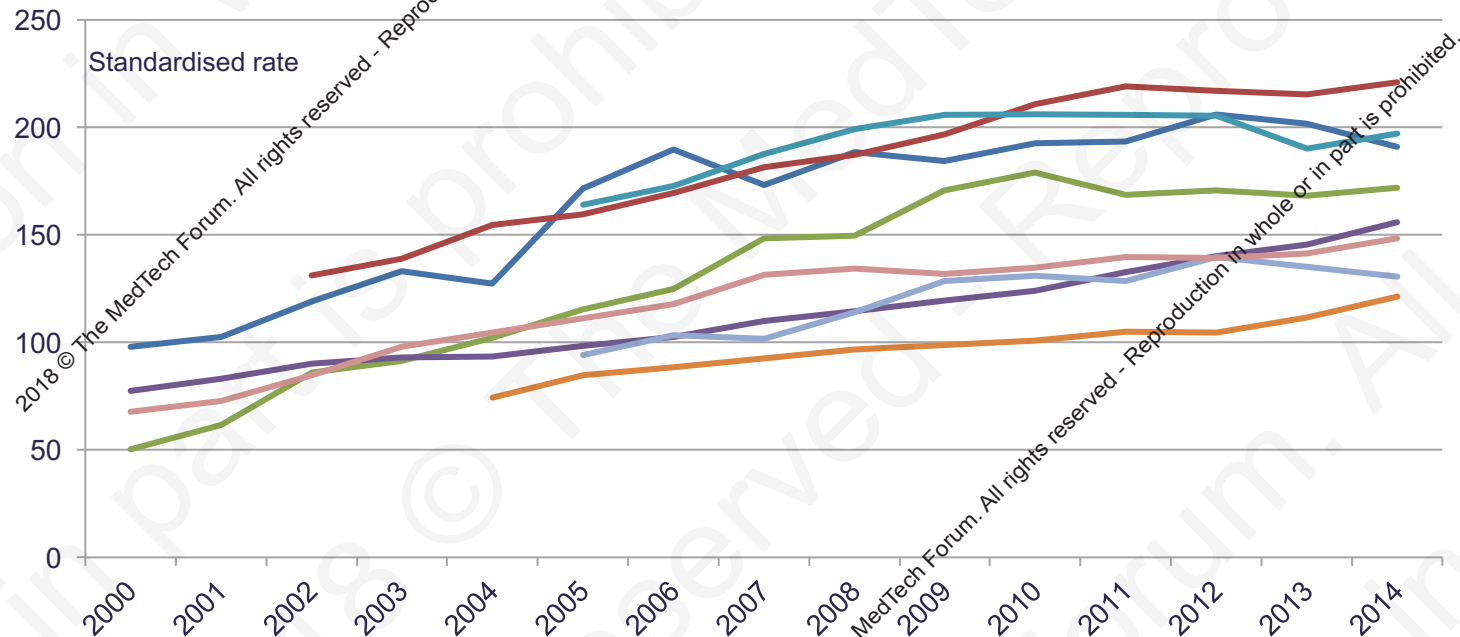

Outputs \neq outcomes

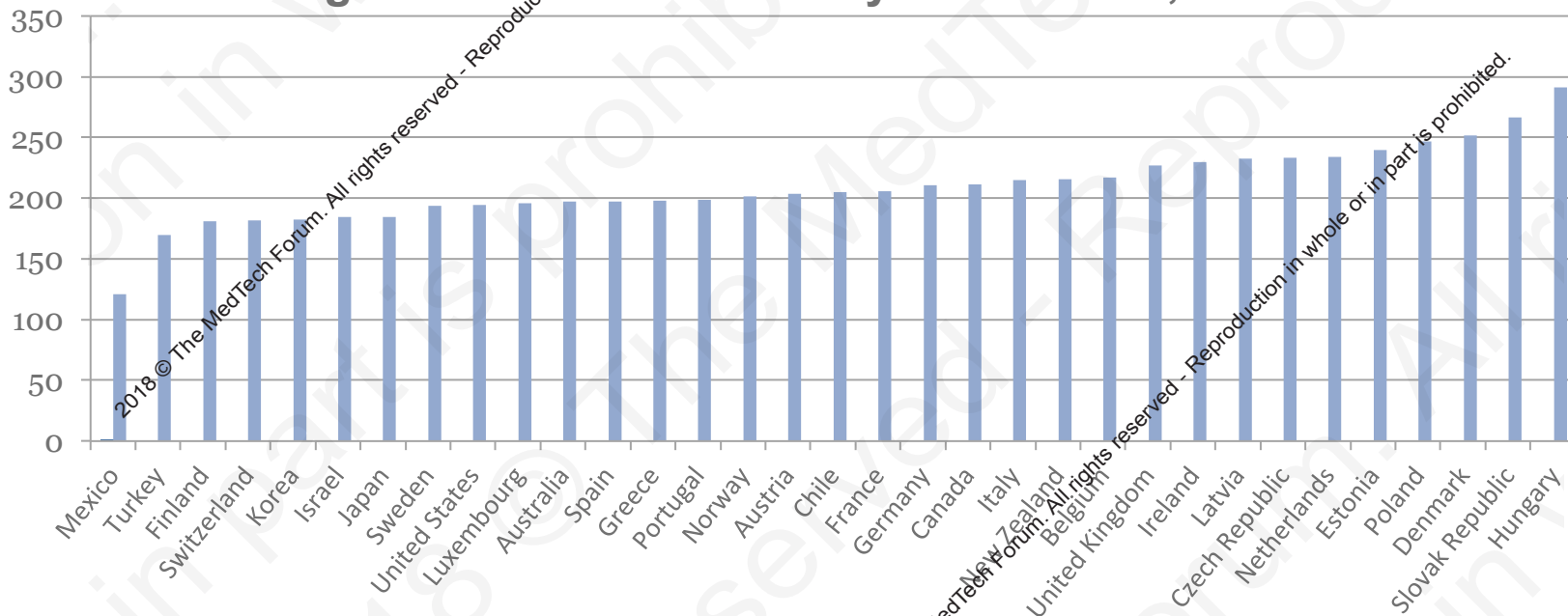
Total knee replacement rates 8 EU countries





'Hard' outcomes are very important.....

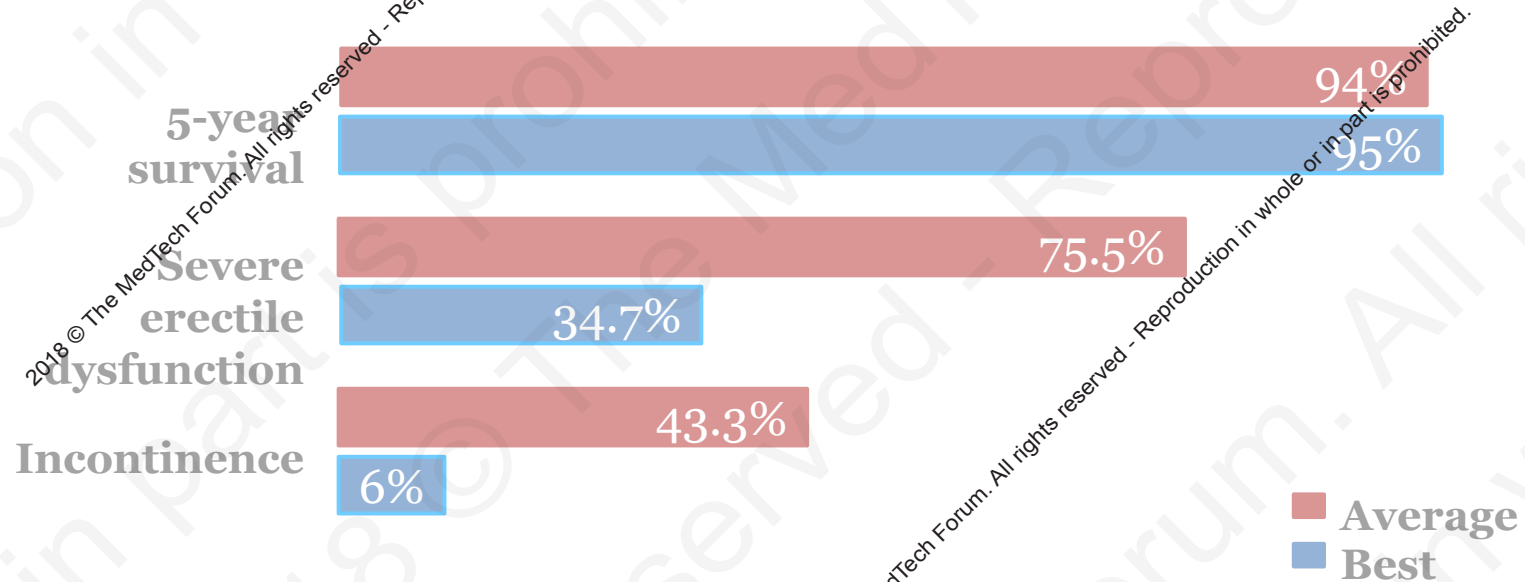
Age-standardised mortality from cancer, 2013

Patient – Reported Indicators Survey

The next generation of OECD health statistics



1. Specific conditions: supporting national health systems to collect patient-reported indicators in a comparable way

Accelerate and standardise work already underway

Cancer care, hip & knee replacement, mental health

2. Complex needs: addressing critical gaps in the measurement of patient-reported indicators

Develop new surveys, direct to patients and carers

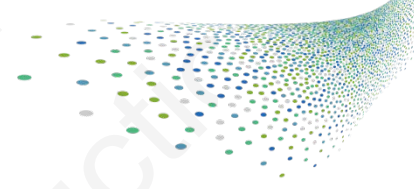
